Homework Help

Does your child need assistance with planning, organizing, and daily school work? Homework assistance is offered weekly throughout the calendar school year. These sessions range from 1-2 hours depending on your child's grade.

The subscription (in detail below) is not required for homework help. However, if your child does not have homework or studying provided by the school on a tutoring night, any custom curriculum creation will be invoiced accordingly. Therefore, the subscription is highly recommended for all programs.

Orton Gillingham Tutoring

Orton Gillingham is a science-based reading approach that has been proven to help children for over 100 years. This structured literacy approach is appropriate for Kindergarten-fifth grade students who are struggling in reading. A note-OG tutoring requires a minimum of 45 minutes-2x a week, to be effective. Megan Yabani is an Associate with the AOGA, and a member of the Academy.

Summer Tutoring

Group Sessions

Our virtual group tutoring sessions offer focused, engaging academic support in a small online setting. Each session includes just three students: one mentor who is one grade level ahead and two students from the grade below. A qualified teacher leads the session, while the mentor assists by modeling strategies and reinforcing key skills. This structure builds confidence, strengthens foundational learning, and supports student growth.

Tutoring Locations

We offer a variety of tutoring services specifically for PreK-7th grade. Take a look below to find where your child may fit best.

Virtual Tutoring

Virtual Tutoring is offered for families who are outside the Giving Tree Tutoring radius. If you are outside of Durham, NC, virtual is your best bet. We use Zoom & Canva for tutoring. *Children must have a whiteboard or the ability to write on their tablet or laptop.*

Hybrid Tutoring is a blend between virtual and in-home tutoring. Example: Tuesdays are in-person 3:30-4:30 (before your child's soccer practice), then Thursdays are Virtual 4:00-5:00. This gives your child the best of both worlds!

In-Home tutoring is possible if you are located in Durham, NC, within 8 miles of Giving Tree Tutoring. My dog, Luna, comes tutoring with me. (She usually falls asleep, so not the greatest assistant.)

Subscription

At Giving Tree Tutoring we like to minimize additional charges. Being a part of your child's education journey often involves tasks outside of the tutoring hour. With a monthly subscription, you are able to cover 99% of what the tutor will provide.

What is included: (rate is per child)

Partnership with Schools

- Collaboration with teachers, therapists, psychologists, etc.

Our Policies

Communication and Payment

Following the consultation, an informal report is written and tutoring goals are created. Updates on progress will be shared through email as well as a cumulative report every semester (2x/year). Invoices are sent to caregivers monthly, automatically through TutorBird. Credit card, Zelle, Venmo & Cashapp are accepted. Payment is due within 1 week of receipt. Failure to pay can result in suspension of services until payment is received.

Attendance and Cancellation Policy

All tutoring sessions begin and end promptly at a mutually agreed and scheduled time. During the school year, sessions are expected on an ongoing weekly basis, unless your child's school is closed for holidays, or prior notice is given. In cases of inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances, I may be unable to make the trip for an in-home tutoring session. In such situations, sessions will automatically transition to virtual format unless you are a *Legacy Family* or the student is below 2nd grade. I will notify you in advance if this change is necessary.

There is no charge for a session that is cancelled with up to 24 hours notice. Tutoring sessions cancelled within 24 hours will incur a charge of 50%. Each family receives a one time cancellation pass each year (within the 24 hour time frame), regardless of reason. Legacy families receive 2.
